

2 tie bars will be provided for which you will be required to cut down in order to make 4 tie bars in total.

To do this, you would first need to unscrew the tips from the threaded bolt and pull back the tube.



To the right is an image of how the tie bars should look once step 1 is completed.



The tube is to be cut into 2 parts (approx. 4cm each).

The threaded bolt is to be cut to ensure there is around a 1cm difference in the tip and tube once fitted as shown to the right.

The threaded bolt would then need to be screwed back into the tips until secure. The tube would then need to be placed over the threaded bolt and over the tips as shown in the picture on the next page.

In order to install these, please secure the rods with the nuts and washers provided into the bumper and splitter (customer would be required to drill 5mm holes into the splitter according to customer preference).
